## **Allen Johnson** (Writer & Performer)

Spent much of the 1990's traveling the United States, performing monologues and spoken word pieces at venues from New York City's **ABC No Rio** to San Francisco's **Paradise Lounge**.

Johnson developed *Another You* over the course of the last several years.

**Sean Ryan** (Director & Collaborator) has been directing performance in Seattle since 1998. Credits include the West Coast premiere of *Crave* by **Sarah Kane**, *InterCut*, an original theater work by Charter<sup>77</sup>, *Always* by Angela DiMarco, Best Director Award for *Escurial* by Michel de Ghelderode (Calgary, Alberta), among others. From 2001-2003, Sean created VIA's PlayLab, a playreading series dedicated to presenting new work from Northwest playwrights, as well as introducing experimental and contemporary works by regional, national, and international playwrights. This series inspired the two year process of Johnson's *Another You*, and the creation of a beautiful friendship. While not directing, Ryan

is on the board of Rain City Projects, a non-profit organization dedicated to the support of Northwest playwrights through its on-line script warehouse and Manifesto Series. He dances with **Scott/ Powell Performance** which performs *locate*, April 20-22 in PNB's Celebrate Seattle Festival; he is the dramaturge for **WET**'s reworking of *Hedda Gabler*; as well as working on a film, *Stop Action Set*, with NW Film Forum's Adam Sekuler. Lastly, Sean Ryan is On the Boards Regional Programs Coordinator and works as a carpenter.
